Discipline Contract

Appropriate behavior is anticipated from the children enrolled in Grand View Health Children's Center Summer Camp Program.

Children are expected to:

- 1. Respect other children and staff persons
- 2. Demonstrate good manners
- 3. Follow directions and instructions of staff
- 4. Take proper care of property and materials used
- 5. Demonstrate kindness and concern in actions and words

Children will not be permitted to:

- 1. Use abusive or vulgar language or gestures
- 2. Demonstrate backtalk or disrespect toward staff
- 3. Hit, push, bite or hurt others in any way

Children who behave in an unacceptable manner will be disciplined in one or more of the following ways:

- 1. Time away from activity
- 2. Restricted playtimes
- 3. Loss of field trip

If one of these actions do not curb the misbehavior, the child's parents will be notified. Continuous misbehavior will result in dismissal from the program.
