IBCLCs are highly trained professionals who help moms establish and sustain breastfeeding, even complex or high-risk situations.

Breastfeeding Support Following Delivery

After your baby's delivery, one of our lactation consultants will visit and observe you and your baby during your hospital stay. Their goal is to understand your personal breastfeeding needs and address any questions or concerns you have to help ensure breastfeeding success. They will show you various positions for optimal latching, feeding and burping, and teach you how to recognize your baby's hunger cues and feeding habits. Our IBCLCs are staffed seven days a week, including most late evenings.

Classes and Support Groups

Grand View Health offers additional ways to help you learn about breastfeeding before and after the birth of your baby through a breastfeeding class and support group.
